## Nuclear Medicine Upgrade

Transformation Grant Funds New Molecular Imaging Equipment With Shorter Scan Times, Higher Scan Resolution

Bertrand Chaffee Hospital has upgraded its nuclear medicine camera equipment with support from the New York State Department of Health and its Statewide Healthcare Facility Transformation Program.

"This state-of-the-art camera has the ability to perform diagnostic and heart/cardiac studies," said Lisa Smith, Imaging Department Manager. "This machine has a faster scan time and higher resolution than our previous camera."

She continued, "This equipment is up and running after an intensive three-month effort, and we thank the community for its patience as we transitioned to this new system."

"The imaging projects within our grant are a key part of our strategy to offer local health services that are vital to our rural population," said Nils Gunnersen, CEO. "We appreciate that the Springville-Griffith Community Education Foundation provided funding towards this

project as well."

Studies available with this nuclear medicine camera include: scans of bone, lung, spleen, thyroid, liver, brain, and breast; scans for GI bleeding and gastric emptying; a white blood cell extremity scan; and, cardiac stress and cardiac non-stress scans.



## Looking Ahead

Now that Bertrand Chaffee Hospital has two of our Imaging projects completed, we look ahead to the two largest work efforts within the scope of our grant: a new MRI and housing, and a new medical arts building.

MRI: Our current magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) equipment is a three-day-a-week service that is housed on a portable trailer.

Our plan is to construct a dedicated building to house a permanent MRI machine on our campus, with easy access for outpatient appointments, emergency patients and those staying on our acute care floor.

Medical Arts Building: This multi-year project will involve developing a site on our campus for an efficient, modern complex to house our Primary Care Center, offices for medical specialties, and outpatient services that are not currently available in the area. ♥
